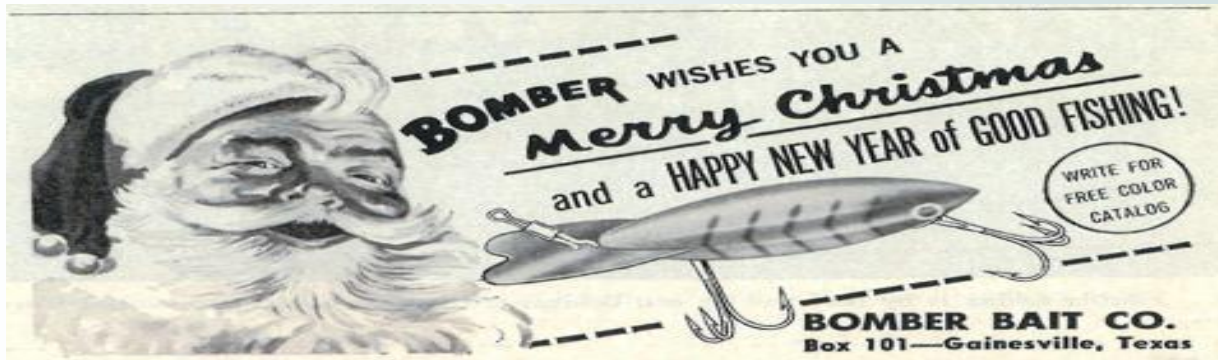

CATC Vice President and Directors elected at 2010 Fall Show

The annual Fall Show business meeting was held on Sunday, November 21st in Myrtle Beach. On the agenda were the election of a club Vice President and three Directors for the two year terms of 2011 and 2012. John Walker had been our Vice President since his initial election in 2006, and was reelected at the 2008 Fall Show. The Director positions are new to the Board, and were authorized by a change to the CATC bylaws voted in by members at the 2010 Spring Show business meeting.

Prior to the Fall Show business meeting, the CATC Board had received the nomination of Elizabeth Yates for the Vice President position, and nominations for Directors as follows: for North Carolina Hoyt Royal from Winston-Salem; for South Carolina Jack Gallagher from Manning; and for all other states Harry Matthews from Hoschton, Georgia.

President Walt Maynard opened the meeting, announced the officer positions to be elected and the nominations received to date, and asked if there were other nominations for these Board positions. No other nominations were received, and the members listed above were elected to their respective posts by voice vote of the members present. Walt then asked the membership if there were other issues to be addressed at the business meeting, and none were raised. The meeting was then closed.

The next CATC election of officers will occur at the 2011 Fall Show, where the President and Secretary/Treasurer positions will be filled.
